UCI LAW MOOT COURT COMPETITION 1L FELLOW & BAILIFF PROGRAM 2024-2025

Thank you for your interest in joining the UCI Law Moot Court Competition. We are excited to offer two unique opportunities for 1Ls this upcoming spring semester. You all play an invaluable role in helping make this competition possible. Please read the below position descriptions to learn more about each opportunity!

1L MOOT COURT FELLOWS

Moot Court 1L Fellows (Fellows) assist the UCI Law Moot Court Board (the Board) with any administrative tasks needed to run the competition. Fellows sign up during the spring semester to assist the Board during the oral argument phase of the 2024-2025 UCI Law Moot Court Competition. During oral arguments, Fellows will help with set-up, greeting volunteer judges, sitting in on arguments, and serving as bailiffs as necessary. 1L Fellows will also have an opportunity to attend board meetings, assist in legal research, and serve as the moot court board's liaison to the rest of the 1L class. This opportunity is for those looking to learn what happens behind the scenes and participate in putting on the Moot Court Competition. The minimum commitment is ten hours across the spring semester, including bailiffing for two 60-minute oral competitions.

1L MOOT COURT BAILIFFS

As a bailiff, individuals act as the official timekeepers for the upcoming UCI Law Moot Court Competition oral argument rounds. Bailiffs will observe the techniques students use to navigate oral argument, learn what judges are looking for, and network with alumni, lawyers, and judges in the Orange County area. The minimum commitment is two 60-minute oral competitions.
